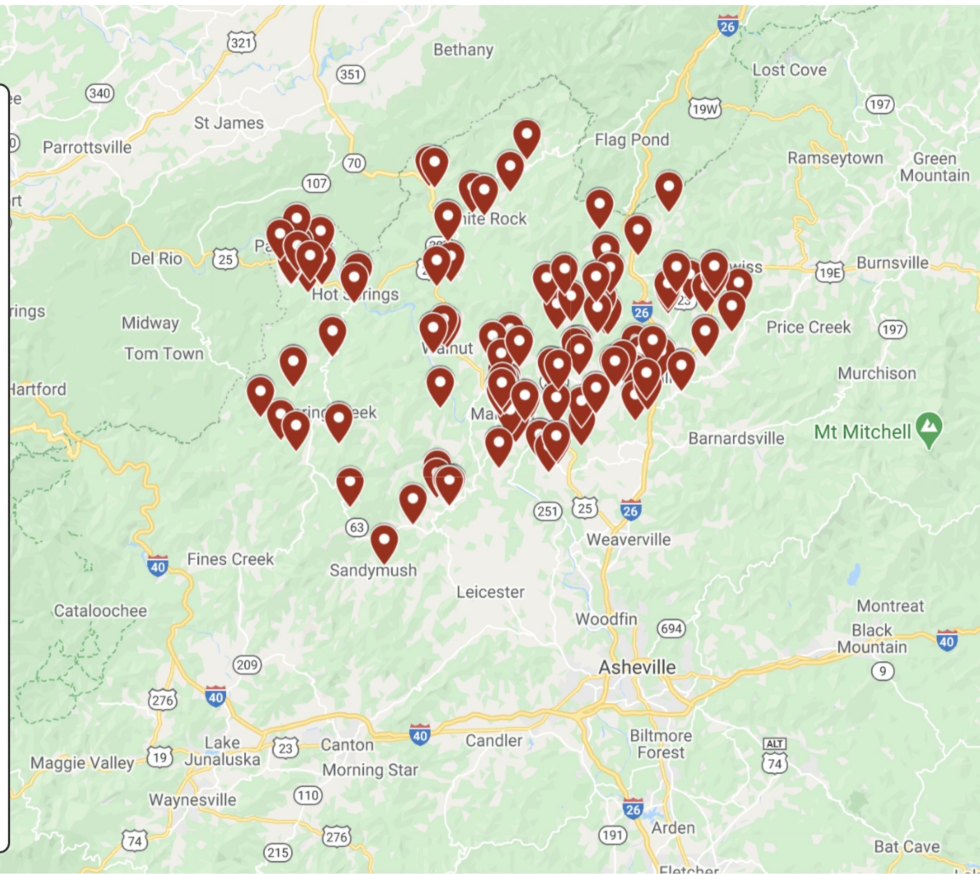

Serving Our Neighbors

Approximately 25% of the Madison County, NC population lives in substandard housing – often residents who own their home but struggle to manage the costs of ownership and general maintenance.

Applicants who request home repair assistance from CHC are assessed for urgency of need, income eligibility, scope of repairs necessary and a holistic overview of circumstances that may be causes of their need. The average CHC client has at least three major home repair needs. Two thirds of our clients are seniors. About one third have disabilities. All are living on very limited incomes generally considered very low, as defined by HUD.
